4 It's been written
"Scripture" is of Latin origin and means "a product of writing."
In its written form, God's Word is still powerful (Matt. 4:1-11). It was written to be read.

5 It's powerful
It is **able**.

7 It's Inspired
The Bible's definition of Inspiration is very precise (2 Samuel 23:2).
The word "inspiration" means "God breathed."
